Welcome to the Funhouse - a few things you should know:

STEPS FOR MISBEHAVIOR

- Warning
- Verbal Contract: Between staff and student. Parents will be informed at pick up.
- Written Contract: Student and staff will fill out written form. Further consequences will be determined by student and staff. Parents will be called immediately.
- Success Plan: Student will be sent home and meeting will be set up between parents and staff to determine next steps.
- Continued behavioral problems may result in permanent dismissal (Refunds will not be given).

I understand and accept the following:

- If my child's behavior seriously violates the safety of any child or staff, I understand that he/she may be temporarily excluded from the program. In these circumstances, I agree that my child will need to be picked up .
- A membership is required for entry to the Funhouse and is not transferable outside of your family or refundable.
- Children in kindergarten and younger must be accompanied by a responsible adult or guardian. Children are required to sign in upon entry. Person picking up child must sign them out and note time.
- The Funhouse Commons is not a licensed child or daycare facility and accepts no responsibility for keeping children in the building or on the premises or after hours if rides are late. If your child is left at the Funhouse after closing you may be charged a fee for staff time.
- Due to budget limitations, the Funhouse Commons will operate with minimal paid staffing and will rely heavily on volunteers. As such, children may not always be under constant supervision.
- Backpacks, large bags, food and drink are not allowed in the building past the entry vestibule.
- The Funhouse staff and/or volunteers reserve the right to ask anyone to leave the Funhouse at any time for any reason.
- I have inspected the grounds (including the playground) and the indoor facility (including the climbing wall & nautical fort) and find them to be safe for me and/or my children to visit and use, as they pertain both to potential physical dangers and to the safety of the building. I understand that I and/or my children use the Funhouse and grounds at our own risk and that where children play, there is usually potential for mishap.
- Our internet stations employ limited parental controls, and we carefully monitor what kids are looking at. It is impossible, however, to unconditionally safeguard against all inappropriate content. I accept this risk in order that members may have access to the tools of the internet.
- There are interior and exterior security cameras (none in bathrooms) that record activities 24 hours/day.

In the case of emergency, I allow The Funhouse staff to summon medical attention for my child and/or myself and I agree to be financially responsible for any resulting medical expenses. The Funhouse will try to reach parents as soon as possible.
