

Information for Parents and Guardians – Fall 2021

THE FUNHOUSE APPROACH TO DISCIPLINE

We use a consistent, positive approach including redirection, diversion and separation, always promoting self-discipline. Parents will be notified if there is a consistent behavior problem.

STEPS FOR MISBEHAVIOR

1. Verbal Warning and redirection.
2. Verbal Contract: Between staff and student. Parents will be informed at pick up.
3. Written Contract: Student and staff will fill out written form. Further consequences will be determined by student and staff. Parents will be called immediately.
4. Success Plan: Student will be sent home and meeting will be set up between parents and staff to determine next steps.
5. Continued behavioral problems may result in permanent dismissal (Refunds will not be given).

We ask you to understand and accept the following before registering your child/children with our programs:

1. Masks must be worn by children and staff at all times during our program, except during snack, and appropriately distanced mask breaks.
2. If my child's behavior seriously violates the safety of any child or staff, I understand that he/she may be temporarily excluded from the program. In these circumstances, I agree that my child will need to be picked up.
3. Children are required to sign in upon entry. Person picking up child must sign them out and note time.
4. The Funhouse Commons is not a licensed child or daycare facility and accepts no responsibility for keeping children in the building or on the premises or after hours if rides are late. If your child is not picked up at The Funhouse after closing you may be charged a fee for staff time.
5. Backpacks, large bags, food and drinks are not allowed in the building past the entry vestibule.
6. The Funhouse staff and/or volunteers reserve the right to ask anyone to leave The Funhouse at any time for any reason.
7. I have inspected the grounds (including the playground) and the indoor facility and find them to be safe for me and/or my children to visit and use, as they pertain both to potential physical dangers and to the safety of the building.
8. I understand that I and/or my children use The Funhouse and grounds at our own risk and that where children play, there is always a potential for mishap.
9. My child(ren) understand(s) the importance of listening to the staff's directions as they are given to help everyone have a fun, safe, and positive Funhouse experience.
10. In the case of emergency, I allow The Funhouse staff to summon medical attention for my child and/or myself and I agree to be financially responsible for any resulting medical expenses. The Funhouse will try to reach parents/guardians as soon as possible.
